The Society operates through its Standing Committee, as we approach our AGM we are looking for new committee members to support the Society during its Bicentenary and beyond. Working closely with education providers to identify areas where seminars and presentations might be useful for members on an ongoing basis. Sourcing speakers. We hold seminars on both black letter law and legal practice and welcome approaches from persons interested in making presentations to our Society members.



Private Client Practice

The Committee welcomes Private Client Solicitors to lead an interest group to develop a programme of seminars to support preservation and growth, tax efficiency, discretion and confidentiality and future planning.



Legal Aid

Legal Aid Solicitors who are willing to report on issues relevant to both criminal and civil legal aid.



Crime

Specialist issues arising in both the Magistrates and Crown Courts including listing, prisons, hearings, IT, consultations and the development of the criminal law estate in Newcastle and the North of England. Representatives on criminal court user groups.



Family

All matters concerning the family courts including the Family and Tribunals Centre in Newcastle. Advising the Committee on key note consultations, listings and remote, hybrid and attended hearings.



Property

We support all Commercial and Residential Property Lawyers by hosting regular Property Law Seminars and are establishing an interest group to share good practice and knowledge to cover all developments in property law.
